



Special Education: A Continuum of Support

District 104 provides access to a full continuum of special education programming including: resource, instructional, and self-contained levels of support. District 104 adheres to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (*IDEA*) with a commitment to educating students with disabilities in the least restrictive environment (*LRE*). To meet the individual needs of all students, programming and related service options are based on the nature and degree of intervention needed for each student.

Levels of Special Education Support within District 104

Resource Level of Support (LRE 1)

- General Education Setting 80-100% of school day/week
- Removal from General Education 0-20% of school day/week

Support Services Include:

- General Education with No Supplementary Aids or Services
- General Education with Supplementary Aids or Services
- General Education with Consultation Support
- Related Service Support within General Education or Special Education Setting (speech/language, social work, etc.)
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within General Education Setting
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within Special Education Setting

Instructional Level of Support (LRE 2)

- General Education Setting 40-79% of school day/week
- Removal from General Education 21-60% of the school day/week

Support Services Include:

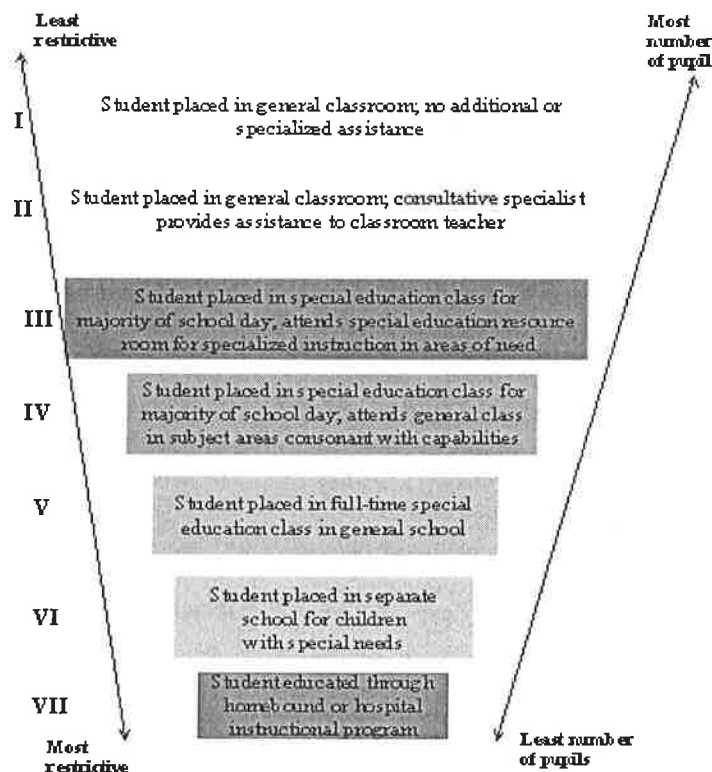
- Related Service Support within General Education or Special Education Setting (speech/language, social work, etc.)
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within General Education Setting
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within Special Education Setting

Self-Contained Level of Support (LRE 3)

- General Education Setting 0-39% of school day/week
- Removal from General Education 61-100% of the school day/week

Support Services Include:

- Related Service Support within General Education or Special Education Setting (speech/language, social work, etc.)
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within General Education Setting
- Support from a Learning Behavior Specialist within Special Education Setting
- Specialized Classroom Support via A.E.R.O Cooperative (Inside and Outside of District 104)
- Separate Special Education Day School Support (Outside of District 104)
- Homebound/Hospitalization Program
